KEY INTERVENTIONS

Over 50% of Bihar's population is multidimensionally underserved. Agriculture, once its economic bedrock, suffers due to reasons ranging from flooding to inadequate farming methods. This results in mass migrations, which bring with it, its own set of problems such as exploitation, food insecurity & health degradation.

HDFC Bank's Holistic Rural Development Programme (HRDP) is working towards improving livelihoods in these villages through:

- Advanced farming practices
- Solar power-based group irrigation to promote multi-cropping
- · Ensuring access to clean drinking water & sanitation
- Promotion of green energy

BIO RESOURCE CENTER: CATALYSING REGENERATIVE AGRICULTURE

| DISTRICTS - BANKA, KISHANGANJ

HDFC Bank Parivartan & Professional Assistance for Development Action's (PRADAN) Bio Resource Center (BRC) trains rural women entrepreneurs to produce bio inputs, reducing chemical use and enhancing regenerative farming. These inputs, including compost and organic solutions, support 300 farmers in cultivating cash crops. The use of 3 metric tons of super compost has boosted yields, improved quality, and increased market value. BRC is driving a sustainable shift towards eco-friendly agriculture.

ENHANCING INCOME THROUGH POLYHOUSE STRUCTURE

| DISTRICTS - BANKA, JAMUI, SAMASTIPUR AND KISHANGANJ

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Professional Assistance for Development Action (PRADAN), is enhancing the incomes of 31 women farmers through polyhouse farming. These structures enable year-round cultivation of high-value crops like seedless cucumber, capsicum, and french beans. Farmers receive training in transplantation, pest management, and market-driven crop selection, allowing them to sell early for better prices. With seasonal earnings of Rs.35,000 - Rs.40,000 per farmer, this initiative promotes financial independence and sustainable agriculture.

CATTLE FEED ENTERPRISE FOR RURAL PROSPERITY

| DISTRICT - BEGUSARAI

With support from HDFC Bank Parivartan, NIRDESH and Sadhna Swayam Sahayita Sumuh, a group of 11 women in Chakka Village, have launched *Bhagirath Pashu Aahar Utpadan Kendra* under the Holistic Rural Development Programme. This community enterprise produces and sells cattle feed, addressing fodder shortages and boosting women's incomes. Initially focusing on *chokar*, *pellet*, and *flour/maida* production, members earn Rs.7,000 per month, with potential growth to Rs.10,000 - Rs.15,000.

REVITALISING RURAL LIVELIHOODS

DISTRICTS - BHAGALPUR, BAHRAICH, ALMORA

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Society for the Upliftment of Villagers & Development of Himalayan Areas (SUVIDHA) are enhancing rural incomes through sustainable, chemical-free farming and community enterprises. The initiative supports organic basmati rice production and Bhagalpur silk handloom units, strengthens Village Development Committees (VDCs), Producer Groups, and Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs), and promotes organic methods, integrated pest management, and mechanised farming. It also improves water storage, rainwater harvesting, micro-irrigation, and solar energy adoption. By integrating these efforts, the project fosters economic growth, environmental sustainability, and agricultural resilience.

NURTURING RURAL ENTREPRENEURSHIP

DISTRICTS - ARARIA, KATIHAR

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Professional Assistance for Development Action (PRADAN), is fostering rural entrepreneurship and economic growth. The initiative supports 20,000+ women and youth with training in farm and non-farm enterprises, introduces solar-powered irrigation and bio-resource centers, and strengthens community institutions like Village Development Committees and Farmer Producer Organisations. It also expands cultivable land with solar-based lift irrigation and improves market access for farmers. This holistic approach enhances productivity, sustainability, and economic resilience in rural communities.

HOLISTIC TRANSFORMATION FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE DISTRICT - BHOJPUR

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Bhartiya Jan Utthan Parishad are redefining rural prosperity in Bihar's Shahpur and Bihiya blocks. By strengthening farmer cooperatives, tool banks, and producer organisations, the initiative boosts market access and productivity for over 5,000 farmers. It introduces solar irrigation, polyhouses, and rainwater harvesting to enhance crop yields and water management. Beyond agriculture, the project fosters alternative livelihoods for 2,000 individuals, upgrades 20 schools with smart learning tools, delivers healthcare through mobile camps, and empowers 500 women in Self Help Groups (SHGs) - paving the way for a self-reliant, thriving community.

| DISTRICT - MUZAFFARPUR

HDFC Bank Parivartan and NIRDESH are turning 15 villages into hubs of sustainable development, impacting 24,000+ lives. The initiative uplifts education, livelihoods, and infrastructure by:

- Training 2,000+ farmers in chemical-free farming and intensive vegetable cultivation
- Establishing rural enterprises for mustard oil, lac bangles, and millet processing
- Upgrading 12 schools, 10 anganwadi centers, and tackling dropout rates
- Boosting clean energy and water access with solar irrigation, streetlights, and improved sanitation

By integrating innovation with community-driven growth, this initiative is building self-reliant, thriving villages.

REVIVING RURAL ROOTS

| DISTRICT - MADHUBANI

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Aident Social Welfare Organisation are transforming 15 villages in Harlakhi and Basopati, impacting 89,000+ lives through education, livelihoods, and infrastructure development.

Key initiatives include:

- Eco-friendly farming training for 3,000 farmers and sustainable irrigation across 190 acres
- 200 acres dedicated to diversified vegetable cultivation & 145 women-led enterprises promoted
- 16 smart schools, clean drinking water, and renewable energy in all villages
- Strengthening 93 community institutions and planting 1,250 trees for environmental resilience

By integrating sustainability with empowerment, this project is paving the way for self-reliant rural communities.

A HOLISTIC APPROACH TO RURAL DEVELOPMENT | DISTRICT - SARAN

In partnership with Aga Khan Rural Support Programme India (AKRSPI), HDFC Bank Parivartan is transforming 15 villages in the Maker block, benefiting 20,000+ people across 3,503 households. The initiative aims to enhance education, healthcare, sanitation, livelihoods, and clean energy through:

- Vegetable cultivation for 1,000 farmers, 15 farmer field schools, 300 nutrition gardens
- Micro-enterprises for 100 households, beekeeping & mushroom farming for 60 women
- 28 solar irrigation units, 150 solar streetlights, 184 biogas units
- Smart upgrades for 12 schools, improvements in 8 ICDS centres
- Strengthening Self Help Groups (SHGs), Village Development Committees (VDCs), water user groups & producer groups

This initiative will foster sustainable rural growth through strategic interventions over the next 2-3 years.



EMPOWERING FARMERS WITH SUSTAINABLE AGRICULTURE AND ENVIRONMENTAL REJUVENATION

| STATES - JHARKHAND, BIHAR, ODISHA, CHHATTISGARH, RAJASTHAN, MADHYA PRADESH. AND WEST BENGAL

Empowering small and marginal women farmers, this initiative by HDFC Bank Parivartan and Professional Assistance for Development Action (PRADAN) focuses on sustainable natural resource management and enhanced agricultural productivity. By creating 30,000 acres of irrigated land through farm ponds, wells, and water harvesting, the project ensures food security and higher farm incomes.

Key interventions include:

- Double cropping and improved farming techniques to boost yields
- Women-led skill training in agriculture, poultry, goat farming, and fisheries
- Bio-resource centers and micro-irrigation systems for sustainable growth
- Strengthening local institutions for long-term rural resilience
- Installing solar streetlights, home lighting, and irrigation pumps across 13 villages

This initiative reduces distress migration, fosters self-reliance, and transforms rural economies.

BREATHING NEW LIFE INTO RURAL COMMUNITIES

STATES - UTTARAKHAND, ASSAM, AND BIHAR

Breaking barriers of geographical isolation, resource scarcity, & seasonal migration, HDFC Bank Parivartan & Mahatma Gandhi Sewa Ashram's initiative 'Saksham' is transforming lives across 20 villages. By uplifting women, youth, farmers, and students, the initiative fosters economic growth, education, and sustainability.

Key interventions include:

- Year-round farming with 120 solar-powered water pumps and intercropping training for 500 farmers
- 42 new enterprises, including 32 women-led businesses and two Khadi micro-enterprises
- Smart school upgrades, clean drinking water in 20 schools, and modernised healthcare in 12 sub-centers
- 1.18 Lakh trees planted to enhance soil fertility and prevent erosion

- Education & employment opportunities for long-term change

Key interventions include:

- · Empowering women to address child safety and welfare
- Creating safety networks to detect and prevent exploitation
- Awareness sessions for families on child protection
- Linking families to schemes that support children's education

By fostering safer schools and stronger communities, the project ensures a future free from social evils, where education thrives.

ZERO INVESTMENT INNOVATIONS FOR EDUCATION INITIATIVES (ZIIEI)

One of the largest ever programmes of its kind to facilitate wide-scale implementation of low-cost innovations, Parivartan & ZIIEI have oriented 65 education officers while 40,280 schools have implemented its ideas thus far.



DIGITISING EDUCATION IN BIHAR

DISTRICTS - AURANGABAD, NAWADA

With the aim of making technology available to all, HDFC Bank Parivartan along with Bhartiya Jan Utthan Parishad (BJUP) and Rashtriya Gramin Vikas Nidhi (RGVN) have installed smart classrooms in government schools. Digital infrastructure like projectors preloaded with curriculum based content & interactive boards have not just made learning fun but classrooms are now vibrant & student friendly. This intervention has directly impacted over 12,000 students. Teachers too have been trained to make effective use of these advancements. As a result of these classrooms, students have been instilled with new-found confidence & exhibit higher engagement levels.

OPTIMISING LEARNING

During the pandemic, quality education slipped out of reach for many students. To bridge this gap, HDFC Bank Parivartan partnered with Khan Academy in a four-year initiative, providing free, high-quality math resources in English, Hinglish, Hindi, Kannada, Punjabi and Gujarati, aligned with the Indian curriculum.

Key highlights:

- 150,000 students from grades 6-12 gained access to interactive online learning
- 3,000+ teachers across 1,500 schools received tools to enhance student outcomes
- Focused on Jawahar Navodaya Vidyalayas and government-funded schools, ensuring wider accessibility

In collaboration with Pratham Education Foundation, this initiative is set to transform lives by providing quality education and skill-building opportunities to underserved communities.

Key highlights include:

- 8,135 unemployed youth to be trained in industry-relevant skills across sectors like healthcare, beauty, hospitality, automotive, and construction
- Providing National Skill Development Council certification, enhancing employability

By equipping youth with practical skills and certification, the project spanning over 3 years creates pathways to sustainable livelihoods and economic independence.

FUELING DREAMS WITH SKILLS

| STATES - JHARKHAND, TELANGANA, MAHARASHTRA, BIHAR, ODISHA, RAJASTHAN, HARYANA, J & K, KARNATAKA

In partnership with Head Held High Foundation, this initiative empowers youth, women, and artisans from underserved communities through skill training, financial literacy, and entrepreneurship.

- 1,500 individuals trained for better careers
- 750 unschooled youth prepared for jobs
- 1,750 youth supported with entrepreneurship skills
- 2,250 women & artisans gain digital, financial skills & ONDC access, fostering 300 microenterprises
- 2,350 households access financial inclusion

Impacting 6,550 lives, this project drives economic independence and opportunity.

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Apollo Hospitals Educational & Research Foundation are bridging the skill gap in healthcare by training 4,500 youth, with 80% women, over four years. This initiative provides employment-linked training, ensuring 70% job placements with fair wages. Training centers in semi-urban and rural areas will offer industry-aligned courses, boosting employability and retention in the healthcare sector.

The initiative focuses on water conservation, solar energy adoption, and sustainable resource optimisation to enhance livelihood and economic stability. By implementing eco-friendly solutions and promoting efficient resource use, the project empowers rural communities to become more self-reliant while ensuring environmental sustainability. This initiative is not just about conservation—it's about creating resilient, thriving villages with access to sustainable livelihoods and a better quality of life.





STORIES OF PARIVARTAN

GOAT REARING: A PATH TO ECONOMIC INDEPENDENCE

LOCATION - BEGUSARAI BENEFICIARY - SAMSA BEGUM

THE CHALLENGE

In a quiet village where opportunities are few and dreams often go unheard, Samsa Begum worked hard just to make ends meet. With no stable income and little knowledge of livestock care, she struggled to rear goats. Her animals often fell ill due to lack of vaccinations, poor nutrition, and inadequate shelter. Though determined, Samsa lacked the tools and training needed to break the cycle of poverty.

OUR INTERVENTION

Through the support of HDFC Bank Parivartan and NIRDESH, Samsa was given a fresh start. She received three female goats and one male goat, along with hands-on training in modern goat-rearing practices. Fodder, vaccinations, and regular veterinary check-ups were provided. Visits from trained *Pashu Sakhis* not only improved the condition of her goat shelter but also created awareness in the village about animal care and welfare.

THE RESULT

From four goats to a thriving herd of sixteen, Samsa's journey is nothing short of inspiring. She has already sold seven goats for Rs.56,000 and continues to nurture the rest for future income. More than just earnings, she has earned the respect of her community. Others have started adopting similar practices, building a ripple of change.

Samsa's story is a testament to how the right support can transform not just livelihoods, but lives.





STORIES OF PARIVARTAN

WOMEN-LED ENTERPRISES: A STORY OF EMPOWERMENT

LOCATION - BASGARA VILLAGE, ARARIA BENEFICIARY - KANCHAN DEVI

THE CHALLENGE

For years, Kanchan Devi's family teetered on the edge of survival. Mounting financial pressure forced them to mortgage two out of their three acres of land. With agriculture as their only source of income, uncertainty loomed large. Kanchan, a homemaker with dreams beyond the kitchen, longed to contribute—but lacked the means, knowledge, and platform.

OUR INTERVENTION

Through the HDFC Bank Parivartan and PRADAN's NiRanter Project, Kanchan found her path. With training, resources, and encouragement, she stepped into the world of entrepreneurship, setting up a polyhouse nursery. With the support of her family and village, she nurtured 27,000 saplings of cauliflower, cabbage, capsicum, green chili, tomato, and broccoli—plants that carried the seeds of a new beginning.

THE RESULT

In just three months, Kanchan earned Rs.29,000, with a net profit of Rs.22,000—a powerful testament to what women can achieve when given the opportunity. Her polyhouse is now not just a source of income, but a symbol of hope.

Kanchan's journey has inspired other women in the village to follow her lead, sparking a wave of change rooted in resilience and growth.

BREAKING BARRIERS, BUILDING FUTURES

On November 19th, women changemakers came together to celebrate Women Entrepreneurs Day organised by HDFC Bank Parivartan & PRADAN. The event was filled with inspiring stories from Sindhu Didi, a Paravet and Pashu Suvidha Kendra owner, to Mridula Didi, who overcame barriers to form SHGs. FPO leaders shared insights, and community leaders encouraged women to take charge of their futures. From *Pashu Sakhis* to polyhouse entrepreneurs, every story proved one thing when women lead, communities thrive. The day ended with a powerful reminder: financial independence isn't just personal success; it's community transformation.

SKILLS TO SUCCESS: BRIDGING YOUTH WITH OPPORTUNITIES

A dynamic skill development and job fair initiative is rolling out across multiple districts, equipping local youth with in-demand vocational skills in sectors like healthcare and automotive. With a mix of hands-on and classroom training, participants gain both technical know how and essential soft skills. Job fairs in each district will connect them directly with potential employers, opening doors to real opportunities. By linking skills with jobs, this initiative by HDFC Bank Parivartan and Pratham Education Foundation isn't creating careers - it's strengthening communities and boosting local economies.





EMPOWERING FARMERS FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE

In a major step towards rural revitalisation, HDFC Bank Parivartan and PRADAN organised an impactful MPA Mela in Banka, uniting 150 farmers to boost productivity through crop clusters in brinjal, chilli, paddy, and maize. Experts shared modern techniques, promoted FPO benefits, and introduced a WhatsApp chatbot for easy seed purchases and payments. With a strong focus on community, especially women, the event blended knowledge, technology, and collaboration, empowering farmers to grow smarter, earn better, and build a sustainable future.


HDFC Bank Parivartan empowers individuals with financial literacy and fraud awareness through engaging digital initiatives.

We promote sustainable agriculture through better water management systems and construction of check dams, farm ponds and irrigation systems. By creating seed & grain banks, village nurseries, and kitchen gardens the initiative helps small-scale food producers boost their yields and earnings.

Parivartan also focuses on building strong value chains, ensuring that farmers get fair prices for their produce. By strengthening rural economies, these interventions help secure a stable food supply and improve the livelihoods of farming communities.

SDG 3: Good Health and Well Being

The bank has also set a guiness World Record in organizing the largest blood donation drive in the world.

The bank has also created requisite infrastructure for students to access education in a safe and lively environment.

By making adequate and equitable sanitation accessible, the bank has helped end Open Defection and offered women their dignified access to sanitation.





SDG 7: Affordable and Clean Energy

To promote sustainable energy solutions, Parivartan is providing solar streetlights, biomass stoves, community biogas plants and home solar lights. By introducing solar power and other clean energy solutions, we are ensuring that remote communities have reliable electricity and supporting economic development by enabling businesses, schools and healthcare centers to function more effectively.

SDG 8: Decent Work and Economic Growth

Administering and enhancing skills is an essential component in increasing employment, ensuring fair share of work and creating sustainable livelihood opportunities. In addition, the bank also focusses on developing livelihood opportunities for women. The bank is working to provide access to affordable, technical and vocational education.

The bank has facilitated the development of dairy cooperatives, poultry farms, integrated poultry-goat rearing-fishery units and other small business to ensure sustained and inclusive growth of the people as well as the region.

We are also skilling youth in futuristic skills including green jobs, information technology, business process management, data analytics, and banking and financial sector.
