KEY INTERVENTIONS

BUILDING RESILIENT RURAL COMMUNITIES

DISTRICTS - WAYANAD, IDUKKI

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with the M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF), implemented a project to enhance the livelihoods and economic security of rural communities, with a special focus on spice farmers. The initiative improved farm productivity, promoted climate-resilient practices, and created sustainable livelihood opportunities.

- Enhanced incomes of 6,350 farmers through improved agricultural practices, pest and disease management, and agri-entrepreneurship support
- Established cattle feed, bio-input, and nursery units, ensuring quality fodder, planting material, and farm inputs
- Promoted bamboo-based crafts and spice/agri-processing centres to diversify income sources
- Planted 2,000 fruit trees and installed 200 solar streetlights, improving public spaces and reducing CO₂ emissions
- Strengthened education by equipping 20 schools with smart classrooms

UPLIFTMENT OF TRIBAL COMMUNITIES THROUGH SKILL BUILDING

| DISTRICT - TRIVANDRUM

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Dhan Foundation, launched a Holistic Rural Development Programme to enhance the well-being of the Kaani tribal community across 30 talukas in Nemangad and Neyyattinkara villages. This initiative promotes self-help groups and enterprise units like rubber band production, chips making, and Soap Oil Units. It also boosts education by setting up smart schools and supports natural resource conservation through tree plantation and the installation of solar-powered lights. These interventions have benefited nearly 15,000 people. The community has become self-reliant, earning higher incomes, and their overall lifestyle has vastly improved.

BUILDING RESILIENT FARMING COMMUNITIES

DISTRICT - ERNAKULAM

HDFC Bank Parivartan and M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF) are empowering farmers in Ernakulam with sustainable solutions to counter climate challenges. The initiative supports dairy, agro-processing, and catering units, benefiting local livelihoods. It promotes goat rearing, precision farming, and drip irrigation while enhancing education through smart classrooms and school renovations. Solar street lights and irrigation support improve infrastructure. By boosting incomes and agri-entrepreneurship, this project strengthens over 500 farmers' resilience, ensuring long-term sustainability.

| DISTRICT - IDUKKI

HDFC Bank Parivartan and M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF) are revitalising agriculture and tourism in Devikulam, to uplift rural communities. The initiative empowers farmers with polyhouses, apiculture, medicinal farming, floriculture and improved irrigation while integrating farm tourism for additional income. It enhances education, healthcare, and financial literacy, benefiting over 600 farmers and youth

ROOTS OF RESILIENCE | DISTRICT - ERNAKULAM

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with the M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF), is supporting a multi-faceted rural development initiative in five clusters of a disaster-prone district facing the impacts of climate change. The project focuses on increasing the income of over 1 Lakh farmers through value-added agri-products and enterprise development. Activities include the setup of agro-processing units for rice, fish, and dairy, along with support for pokkali rice market linkages and dairy-based entrepreneurship. Handloom modernization and mangrove conservation further diversify livelihood options. Emphasis is placed on community-based natural resource management, resilient farming systems, and inclusive planning with active participation from local institutions and farmers.

ENABLING SMART EDUCATION WITH SMART INFRASTRUCTURE

| DISTRICTS - ERNAKULAM, WAYANAD, IDUKKI, THIRUVANTHAPURAM

HDFC Bank Parivartan along with M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF), Dhan Foundation and Centre for Youth Development and Activities (CYDA) supported schools in promoting smart education for students. The intervention helped to establish high-end interactive display systems and STEM lab components such as student science microscope, sky telescope, 4D human brain model, 4D human heart anatomy model, colour addition LED, frog anatomy model, rain gauge, optical lab set, 3D mathematical resource kit, etc. Parivartan also set up smart language labs that helped improve language proficiency of students.

REVITALISING EARLY EDUCATION SPACES | DISTRICTS - ERNAKULAM, WAYANAD, IDUKKI

HDFC Bank Parivartan and M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF) are working on a significant initiative focused on the renovation of 87 anganwadis and 2 model pre-schools across 34 villages. The intervention focuses on:



- Painting and artwork on walls to create a vibrant and stimulating environment
- Installation of floor mats, tables, and puzzle play mats
- Provision of age-appropriate toys, educational games, and art supplies

This initiative aimed at not only revitalising physical spaces but also creating a more conducive and organised learning environment for young minds. Through artistic enhancements and the infusion of educational resources, the intervention aspired to contribute positively to the early education experience in these communities.

| DISTRICTS - THRISSUR, KOZHIKODE, MALAPPURAM, ERNAKULAM

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Centre for Youth Development and Activities (CYDA), is advancing digital education through the setup of four smart classrooms and two smart schools. These digitally-enabled learning spaces are designed to make education more engaging, interactive, and effective for students. By integrating technology into the teaching process, the initiative aims to promote better conceptual understanding and personalized learning experiences. Alongside infrastructure upgrades, capacity-building sessions for teachers on digital classrooms will be conducted to ensure effective implementation. This step marks a shift toward future-ready education, creating an environment where students can thrive and adapt to the evolving demands of the 21st-century learning landscape.

ENTREPRENEURSHIP DEVELOPMENT

| DISTRICTS - ERNAKULAM, IDUKKI & WAYANAD

HDFC Bank Parivartan, along with M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF), is supporting communities in leveraging their skills to build sustainable livelihoods. From seafood processing to spice cultivation, these initiatives aim to strengthen income opportunities and promote long-term economic resilience. This includes:

- 15 seafood processing units & 1 fruit processing unit in Ernakulam; helping locals add value to their produce
- 8 agro product units boosting food processing capabilities
- 6 spice semi-processing centers strengthening the spice value chain
- 1 mini coconut oil mill & outlet supporting local production
- 7 tailoring units & 6 dairy product units creating new income streams for women

ENHANCING EMPLOYABILITY AMONG DIFFERENTLY-ABLED YOUTH

DISTRICT - ERNAKULAM

Parivartan along with Dr. Reddy's Foundation in Kochi is providing training to people with disabilities including individuals who are speech impaired, hearing impaired and visually impaired. The programme's primary focus is on building a skillfully strong youth through focused training in core employability skills. This duration of training is 60 days for age-groups of 18-35 year olds. The beneficiaries are trained in soft skills, english, communication, digital literacy, work readiness and more.

Focussed on improving sanitation facilities and promoting good and safe hygiene practices

KEY INTERVENTIONS

BLOCK LEVEL WASTE MANAGEMENT UNIT

| DISTRICTS - ERATTAYAR, IDUKKI, NENMENI, WAYANAD

HDFC Bank Parivartan and M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF) installed block-level plastic waste baling units with the goal of improving waste management and increasing the income of haritha karma sena members. In Idukki, the project has been a resounding success, with the units now bale up to 1,000 kg of plastic waste per day, three times more than before the intervention. This has reduced storage space requirements and reduced the need for labor. As a result, the average income of HKS - members has increased from Rs.8,000 to Rs.15,000 per month. The project has also helped to reduce plastic waste pollution in the two villages, making them cleaner and more sustainable. This is a shining example of how CSR partnerships can be used to address complex social and environmental challenges. It is also a testament to the hard work and dedication of the Haritha Karma Sena members, who are making a real difference in their communities.

ENABLING INNOVATION IN SANITATION TECHNOLOGY | DISTRICT - PALAKKAD

To strengthen innovation in the Water, Sanitation and Hygiene (WASH) sector, HDFC Bank Parivartan has extended support to the Global Sanitation Center of Excellence (GSCoE) at IIT Palakkad. The project focuses on building facilities for incubation, prototyping, fabrication, and the testing and deployment of sanitation technologies. The GSCoE provides a platform for startups developing device-based solutions that address greenhouse gas (GHG) emissions, toilet efficiency, waste reduction, and energy recovery from waste. Over time, these innovations are expected to contribute to a reduction of over 1 lakh tons of GHG emissions and 5 lakh tons of waste and wastewater, while also improving toilet hygiene and creating employment. The initiative aims to foster scalable, sustainable sanitation solutions nationwide.

KEY INTERVENTIONS

INSTALLING SOLAR STREET LIGHTS TO ASSURE SAFETY ON ROADS

| DISTRICTS - MALAPPURAM, THIRUVANANTHAPURAM, KOZHIKODE, KANNUR, KOLLAM, KASARGOD, WAYANAD, THRISSUR, PALAKKAD, ALAPPUZHA, PATHANAMTHITTA, IDUKKI

HDFC Bank Parivartan along with Dhan Foundation, M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF), and Centre for Youth Development and Activities (CYDA) located the areas that have poor electric connectivity and planned for the installation of solar street lights. The project was established in 80 villages. As a result of intervention, 878 solar street lights were installed in the vulnerable locations where wild animal menace and theft is common. The solar street lights were also installed at village roads near junctions and deep curve roads. The intervention helped regain social safety, especially amongst women and children.

TURNING SPICES INTO STABILITY

LOCATION - NENMENI, WAYANAD BENEFICIARIES - A 10-MEMBER SPICE PROCESSING GROUP

THE CHALLENGE

In Wayanad's forested highlands, many farming families face seasonal instability caused by climate change. Traditional cultivation offers little security, with limited exposure to modern practices, processing infrastructure, or access to wider markets. Without alternative income sources, households remain vulnerable.

OUR INTERVENTION

As part of a local initiative supported by HDFC Bank Parivartan and M S Swaminathan Research Foundation (MSSRF) a ten-member farmer group in Nenmeni began exploring value-added spice processing. They received hands-on training from the Indian Institute of Spices Research (IISR) in Calicut and set up a processing unit equipped with tray dryers, pulverizers, and roasters. Their enterprise, now known as Green Wayanad, produces turmeric, spice blends, coffee, and coconut oil, combining traditional know-how with new skills.

THE RESULT

The group now earns an additional Rs.8,000 per member each month, selling through local market networks, resorts, and designated Parivartan outlets. This growing enterprise is helping build economic stability for participating families and serves as a local model for community-based livelihood diversification.

FROM HARDSHIP TO HOPE: A JOURNEY OF RESILIENCE AND EMPOWERMENT

| LOCATION - COCHIN | BENEFICIARY - ASNA ALI, A YOUNG MOTHER FROM A LOW-INCOME BACKGROUND

THE CHALLENGE

Asna Ali's educational journey was cut short due to family pressures. Later, as a single mother with no stable income, she faced mounting financial challenges and few opportunities for sustainable employment. The uncertainty made it difficult to plan a secure future for herself and her child.

OUR INTERVENTION

Seeking a path forward, Asna enrolled in the nursing assistant course at the Skill Development Training Centre run by the Hope Foundation, with support from HDFC Bank Parivartan. The programme included three months of structured classroom and practical medical training, followed by an internship at Kancare Living Centre. In addition to professional skills, the experience helped her regain confidence and a sense of direction.

THE RESULT

Today, Asna works as a Nursing Assistant at Aster Medcity Hospital in Cochin, earning Rs.15,000 per month. Her journey illustrates how targeted skill-building initiatives can support individuals in rebuilding their lives and entering the workforce with renewed purpose.



The Dairy Support Programme, a key CSR initiative under Financial Inclusion, bridges the gap between rural farmers and mainstream banking. By transitioning dairy payments from cash to digital banking, the programme enhances financial security, promotes savings habits, and builds credit history for farmers - especially women, who play a crucial role in dairy production. Beyond financial empowerment, it aligns with broader rural development goals, fostering economic sustainability and inclusion. By educating farmers on savings strategies and providing access to banking services, the initiative strengthens financial independence and ensures long-term rural prosperity.

PARIVARTAN STARTUP GRANTS

HDFC Bank has concluded 8 editions of its Parivartan Startup Grants, a key initiative under our Corporate Social Responsibility programme aimed at fostering innovation and social impact across India. Since its inception in 2017, the initiative has disbursed around Rs.80 crore+ in grants, supported over 500+ Startups, and partnered with more than 120+ incubation centres across various sectors, including Environment, Education, Agriculture, and Healthcare. This year, we collaborated with 20 incubators to identify and supported 80+ social impact Startups focused on critical areas such as Al for Social Good, Agriculture, Climate Innovations, Financial Inclusion, and Gender Diversity & Inclusion. Selected Startups will receive funding and access to vital capacity-building programmes.


