



- Spread of financial literacy
- Job-oriented youth training

REVIVING RESILIENCE: TRANSFORMING LIFE **IN BORDER VILLAGES** Holistic development in 6 districts

LADHAK, HIMACHAL PRADESH, UTTARAKHAND

Remote villages in Ladakh struggle with inadequate animal health services, poor school enrollment, limited electricity, low agricultural productivity, and inefficient water management, hindering community development and sustainability in harsh conditions. HDFC Bank Parivartan and Himmotthan Society are enhancing the quality of life for 1,200 families through sustainable development and resilience building. Key initiatives include:

- **Smart Schools:** Establishing technology-equipped schools to provide quality education.
- Solar-Powered Village: Installing a 10 kWp off-grid solar power system and 10 solar street lights in each border village.
- **Water Resources:** Refurbishing a water reservoir and rehabilitating five irrigation canals.
- Agriculture: Providing premium seeds for five high-value crops and 100 meters of durable plastic mulch per farmer.

These efforts are fostering sustainable energy, improved education, water security, and agricultural development, paving the way for a better future for rural communities.





GENERATING **SUSTAINABLE** LIVELIHOODS FOR **RURAL WOMEN**

Skill based training to 5 Lakh+ farmers

WEST BENGAL, PUNJAB, ASSAM, JHARKHAND, ODISHA AND **CHHATTISGARH**

HDFC Bank Parivartan worked with Society for Development Alternatives on a Rural livelihoods enhancement programme for skill development with an aim to develop sustainable livelihoods for targeted population and provide means for income generation. Most of the beneficiaries are women who are working as artisans or farmers - landless and landed. The programme aims to economically develop up to 5 Lakh farmers and artisans spread over 120 clusters. This is being done by the way of:

- Encouraging beneficiaries to join and develop through PCs and incubating women-led producer organisations.
- Facilitating skill upgrading among rural women to boost capacities and employability.
- Mobilising rural women into self-help groups (SHGs) and producer organisations (POs) in a phased manner and providing support to help them diversify livelihoods and enhance incomes and quality of life.
- Equipping rural women with greater digital know-how and capabilities.





REVITALISING RURAL **LIVELIHOODS**

3500 marginal farmers to be trained and sustainable farm and non-farm activities

BIHAR, UTTAR PRADESH, UTTARAKHAND

Addressing the agricultural productivity decline and economic challenges prevalent in Bhagalpur (Bihar), Bahraich (Uttar Pradesh), and Almora (Uttarakhand), HDFC Bank Parivartan and SUVIDHA has launched an initiative that focuses on revitalising rural livelihoods. Engaging 3500 marginal farmers, the project aims to transform agricultural practices towards sustainable, chemical-free farming. Through community-led enterprises such as organic basmati rice and Bhagalpur silk handloom units, the aim is to stimulate local economies and ensure sustainable growth. This project also includes:

- Forming and empowering Village Development Committees (VDCs), Producer Groups, and Farmer Producer Organizations (FPOs).
- Providing agricultural inputs and promoting sustainable farming practices such as organic methods and integrated pest management.
- Strengthening water storage and rainwater harvesting systems.
- Developing micro-irrigation facilities and promoting solar energy solutions.
- Expanding agricultural mechanisation through farm tool banks, including power tillers, weeders, and threshers.

Promoting techniques like mulching and chain fencing for enhanced productivity. By integrating these activities, the programme aims to uplift the rural population, reduce poverty, and foster sustainable development through a holistic approach.

In partnership with Tata Education & Development Trust, Parivartan's focused farmer livelihood improvement initiative aims at transforming the lives of the nation's marginal farmers by:

- Establishing self-reliant & business-viable producers' collectives
- Strengthening & establishing linkages with both input & output markets
- Assisting farmers in gradually shifting from their traditional methods into more sustainable systems
- Training and orientation in drip irrigation with mulching for open field precision farming, commercial soil-less nurseries, farm mechanization, brood lac provider, livestock feed management, etc.

Targeting the states of Jharkhand, Odisha, Uttarakhand, Rajasthan, Maharashtra & Gujarat, approximately 20,000 households are estimated to be impacted by the initiative, which aims at irreversibly bringing many farmer households out of poverty.





To improve learning levels of primary class students in targeted government schools, HDFC Bank Parivartan worked with Central Square Foundation and promoted the Foundation, Learning and Numeracy (FLN) Mission. The programme aimed to ensure that every school going child achieves basic competencies of reading with comprehension and foundational mathematics. Approximately 70 lakh stakeholders, including students and teachers, across more than 150,000 government schools with primary grades will be benefiting directly from intervention. The outcomes include reduction in school drop-out rate, enhanced training of teachers, improvement in school attendance and enhanced learning experience.



The 'Unstoppable: Karke Dikhaungi' athlete scholarship programme is a unique project supported by HDFC Bank. The programme was conceptualised to promote and drive further the theme of women in sports, and is curated by GoSports Foundation. Through the programme, talented female athletes across six sports namely - archery, athletics, badminton, swimming, table tennis, and weightlifting - are supported to pursue their careers in sport. 38 girls were shortlisted to receive support through the programme towards several key areas of their requirements such as coaching and training, living expenses for food and accommodation, competition expenses at national and international events, equipment and gear, and various sports science support, such as - sports nutrition, physiotherapy, strength & conditioning, and mental conditioning & psychology. The programme also aims to provide the athletes with mentorship through its network of athletes and experts, with the aim of guiding and helping them unleash their potential on the global sporting stage.





UPSKILLING MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS **IN TRAUMA CENTRES**

Parivartan is organising training sessions for 4,000 doctors in trauma management to curb the number of accidental deaths

GUJARAT, GOA, RAJASTHAN, DELHI, PUNJAB, HARAYANA, MADHYA PRADESH, UTTAR PRADESH

According to NCRB, there has been an upward trend in the number of accidental deaths recorded annually in both rural and urban areas. However, trauma care management is particularly challenging in rural regions in comparison to urban centres, due to lack of trained personnel and inadequate stabilisation. Through this project 4000 AYUSH doctors are being trained through workshops on Primary Trauma Care, providing them with practical experience at various hands-on skill trauma stations. The training has empowered doctors under AYUSH, in understanding the clinical priorities in trauma management, making them competent enough to undertake a rapid systematic assessment and to resuscitate and stabilise trauma patients in environments of limited resources.

We are committed to comprehensively and sustainably design our programmes in a way where we are able to realise our shared goal of a better and peaceful world in 2030.

PARIVARTAN AND THE SUSTAINABLE DEVELOPMENT GOALS

Rural Development

Under Parivartan, the bank has been working in 17+ states in India to bring in holistic development in the rural landscape. It has launched the Holistic Rural Development Programme to address key challenges in rural areas.

SDG 2 ~ Zero Hunger

1. Promoting sustainable agriculture through better water management systems by construction of check dams, farm ponds, community ponds and irrigation systems.

2. Empowering farmers through capacity building. Creating Seed Bank, Grain Bank, Village Nursery and supporting field research to achieve food security.

SDG 6 ~ Clean Water and Sanitation

1. Ensuring availability of clean drinking water and promoting sustainable management of water through construction of Rainwater Harvesting Structures, Community Tanks, Hand Pumps and Wells.

SDG7 ~ Affordable and Clean Energy

1. Adopting renewable energy to provide affordable, reliable, sustainable and accessible modern energy through installation of Solar street lights, Biomass Stoves, Community Biogas Plants and Distribution of Solar Home Lights.





Skill Development and Livelihood Enhancement

Administering and enhancing skills is an essential component in increasing employment, ensuring fair share of work and creating sustainable livelihood opportunities. In addition, the bank also focusses on developing livelihood opportunities for women.

SDG 2 ~ Zero Hunger

1. HDFC Bank Parivartan has created non-farm based employee opportunities to double farmers' incomes. Using productive resources, farmers are trained on livestock management, thus, benefitting indigenous people, women and villagers.

2. The bank introduced kitchen gardens in villages in several states to promote sustainable agriculture and ensured improved nutrition to the families while successfully ending hunger. It has facilitated creation of over 40,000 kitchen gardens.

SDG4 ~ Quality Education

1. Under Parivartan, the bank is working to provide access to affordable, technical and vocational education. The bank has trained over 1.60 lakh individuals under its Skill Development programme keeping with principles of equity and inclusivity.

SDG5 ~ Gender Equality

1. Parivartan has formed/revived over 7,500 SHGs with an aim to empower women in rural India. The initiative has strengthened the cause of achieving gender equality by enabling the women to achieve better livelihood opportunities.

1. The bank has trained over 1.04 lakh farmers through exposure visits and diverse agricultural training programmes for their sustained economic growth. Through varied capacity building initiatives, the farmers are able to seek full and productive employment.

2. Parivartan has empowered farmers through entrepreneurial programmes through financial as well as skill-based support. The bank has facilitated development of dairy cooperatives, poultry farms, integrated poultry-goat rearing-fishery units and other small business to ensure sustained and inclusive growth of the people as well as the region.

















SDG12 ~ Responsible Consumption and Production

1. Through natural farming, formation of seed banks and FPOs, Parivartan has been able to help farmers in innovating their logistics and supply chain, thus enabling sustainable consumption and production patterns.

Promotion of Education

This is one of the most important pillars of Parivartan that promotes equal education to all from early childhood to secondary education. The initiative also advocates usage of technology through digitisation of schools and introducing science labs to encourage the scientific temper of children.

SDG 4 ~ Quality Education

1. To further improve the access to inclusive and equitable quality education, the bank has undertaken several initiatives including remedial classes, learning camps, training the teachers and by offering scholarships. The bank has also created requisite infrastructure for students from underprivileged background to access education in a safe and lively environment.

1. Parivartan has included sports as one of the fundamentals of education to ensure healthy lives of children while promoting their well-being. The bank has facilitated training of hockey, football and other sports while also ensuring access to the requisite sports equipment.

Healthcare and Hygiene

Our bank has actively worked towards providing better healthcare and sanitation facilities to the vulnerable communities. With its special focus in eradicating Non Communicable Diseases in certain states to building accessible sanitation facilities despite challenging terrains, the bank has set an example in the space.


SDG8 ~ Decent Work and Economic Growth
