HOLISTICALLY TRANSFORMING 15 VILLAGES | DISTRICT - FAZILKA

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Ambuja Foundation are leading a transformative initiative across 15 villages in Fazilka, tackling groundwater depletion, soil degradation, and livelihood challenges head-on. This includes:

- Boosting water conservation through micro-irrigation and soil moisture techniques
- Reviving soil health with sustainable farming practices that enhance yields
- Empowering farmers with cost-effective methods for better profits
- Creating income opportunities for landless women through artisan-led skill training
- Modernising schools with smart classes, science centres, and better infrastructure

Beyond this, farmer clubs, cattle health camps, waste management systems, and 9,000 new trees are paving the way for a greener, more resilient future.

HOLISTIC DEVELOPMENT FOR A SUSTAINABLE FUTURE DISTRICT - PATIALA

Transforming 15 villages, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Ambuja Foundation are driving holistic rural development through natural resource management, education, and sustainable livelihoods. This includes:

- Planting 9,000 trees and implementing a robust waste management system
- Boosting farmer incomes through resource management initiatives
- Upgrading 15 government schools into smart schools with improved infrastructure
- Empowering women through artisan enterprises in weaving, knitting, and embroidery

EMPOWERING FARMERS, ARTISANS, AND COMMUNITIES | DISTRICT - MOGA

Bringing new hope to underserved communities, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Ambuja Foundation are driving socio-economic progress in Bagha Purana and Nihal Singhwala blocks. With a strong focus on women and landless farmers, this three-year initiative fosters better livelihoods, improved education, and stronger infrastructure.

Key interventions include:

- Upskilling 400 artisans and training 20 master artisans
- Increasing incomes for 325 farmers through better agricultural practices
- Expanding irrigation to 380 acres of farmland
- Developing 15 smart schools for quality education
- Ensuring clean drinking water in 2 villages with solar-powered jal minars
- Installing solar streetlights in 15 villages
- Supporting 200 farmers in vegetable farming and linking 225 to machinery banks
- Improving soil health through 15 farmer field schools

SUSTAINABLE CROP RESIDUE MANAGEMENT AND AGRICULTURAL ENHANCEMENT

| STATES - PUNJAB, HARYANA

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with The CII Foundation, is addressing crop residue burning in Fatehabad (Haryana) and Sangrur (Punjab) by promoting sustainable agricultural practices and building local livelihood opportunities.

Key interventions include:

- Setting up biomass pellet/briquette-making and straw-based biogas units to convert crop residue into energy and industrial inputs
- Forming and supporting FPOs to run biomass recycling enterprises profitably, with market linkages to local industries
- Deploying farm machinery through tool banks for in-situ and ex-situ straw management
- Training farmers and youth through demonstrations, door-to-door campaigns, and farm advisory services
- Managing 60–70% biomass in-situ and 30–40% through collection and value addition, reducing residue burning and improving air quality
- Monitoring progress through impact assessments and case studies to track environmental and economic outcomes

DEVELOPING FOUNDATIONAL LEARNING AND NUMERACY COMPETENCIES

DISTRICTS - AMRITSAR

In Punjab, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Central Square Foundation (CSF) partnered to transform education at scale. Together, they trained 47,000 teachers and ensured that 85% of classrooms had the necessary materials. With 66,000 classroom visits and guidance from 1,700 mentors, teaching quality saw a strong uplift through hands-on observation and feedback. CSF also supported the state in overhauling teacher training programs and led the development of new, NCF-2022-aligned textbooks, workbooks, and teacher guides—bringing relevant, high-quality learning closer to every child.

STRENGTHENING EDUCATIONAL & MEDICAL INFRASTRUCTURE

| DISTRICTS - BHATINDA, LUDHIANA, TARN TARAN, MANSA, AMRITSAR

HDFC Bank Parivartan along with Society for Action in Community Health is working on developing the educational and medical infrastructure that will positively impact 7,500 individuals from 5 districts of Punjab. Government schools in the region will see improved digital infrastructure and will be converted into smart schools. ICT Labs, music rooms, libraries and science labs will be refurbished and provided with new equipment. Transportation facility will also be made available. Additionally, 1 hospital will be equipped with state-of-the-art facilities which will help in safe and improved diagnosis.

By reducing dropout rates and improving retention, the project fosters a better educational experience. Renovations include repairs, whitewashing, and floor plastering, creating a more engaging environment. With a focus on SDGs like Quality Education and Gender Equality, the initiative is set to make a lasting impact, ensuring students receive modern, technology-driven education.

- Encouraging attendance and reducing dropout rates

EMPOWERING YOUTH THROUGH SKILL DEVELOPMENT DISTRICT - MOHALI

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Orion Educational Society, in collaboration with local stakeholders, is addressing unemployment among underserved youth through a comprehensive skill training initiative. The project aims to upskill 5,070 individuals in sectors like banking, healthcare, media, information technology, and retail, ensuring 75% receive job placements.

Key interventions include:

- · Career counseling, psychometric testing, and industry-aligned training
- · Personality development, grooming, and job etiquette workshops
- Post-placement tracking for sustained employment and career growth

By fostering skill development and economic independence, this initiative is creating lasting opportunities for youth and women.

PROJECT STREE (SOCIAL AND TRANSFORMATIVE RURAL ECONOMIC EMPOWERMENT)

| DISTRICTS - LUDHIANA, MOGA, BARNALA, RUPNAGAR

In Punjab, a focused rural development initiative by HDFC Bank Parivartan, Grant Thornton Bharat LLP and Society for Development Alternatives is empowering women and promoting agri and non-farm sector growth across four districts.

- 17 Farmer Producer Companies (FPCs) led by women have achieved a combined turnover of Rs.13.83 crore to date.
- 22 women certified as drone pilots received drones worth Rs.3.3 crore, enabling precision farming that reduced input costs by 11–13% and increased yields by 4–6%.
- 2 Custom Hiring Centres (worth Rs.60+ lakh) were set up under the Crop Residue Management Scheme to support farm mechanisation and promote a burn-free Punjab.
- Dairy interventions have improved milk yield by 15–20% and enhanced milk quality, boosting incomes for women farmers.
- 22 Common Facility Centres established, including mustard oil and wheat processing units, have opened value-addition and market access opportunities.
- Direct farmer-to-market sales of maize, potatoes, and basmati rice have improved price realisation for producers.



IMPROVING LIVELIHOODS THROUGH NATURAL RESOURCE MANAGEMENT

| DISTRICT - PATHANKOT

Driving change in Dharkalan and Bamial, HDFC Bank Parivartan and PHIA Foundation are tackling soil erosion and water scarcity while empowering local communities. This initiative focuses on:

- Enhancing water storage and rainwater harvesting solutions
- Optimising irrigation with micro-irrigation techniques
- Promoting sustainability through solar energy solutions
- Strengthening community groups like Village Development Committees (VDCs), Producer Groups, and Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs)
- Ensuring access to quality seeds and seedlings
- Encouraging eco-friendly farming with composting and bio-fertilisers

With a focus on biodiversity conservation and income diversification, including fruit and millet processing, this project fosters long-term sustainability and resilience.

Through a series of impactful healthcare and hygiene interventions, HDFC Bank Parivartan is driving change in rural communities. Regular health check-up camps and awareness drives have empowered villagers with knowledge on nutrition, hygiene, and preventive care. Clean drinking water systems have been installed to reduce waterborne diseases, while the construction of community and household toilets has significantly improved sanitation and reduced open defecation. These efforts not only promote healthier lifestyles but also uphold dignity, especially for women and children. By addressing basic health and hygiene needs, the initiative is laying the foundation for stronger, more resilient rural communities.

KEY INTERVENTIONS

SOLAR-POWERED LEARNING REVOLUTION

| DISTRICTS - LUDHIANA, MOGA, AMRITSAR, PATIALA, RUPNAGAR

The initiative, led by HDFC Bank Parivartan and the Society for Action in Community Health, aims to provide solar energy systems to 20 schools and colleges in Punjab, benefitting underserved students. The project will install 10KVA solar power units to reduce electricity costs, ensuring that children from lower-income families have access to affordable, quality education. The adoption of solar energy will reduce electricity expenses in 20 educational institutions, impacting 12,000 students.

CREATING CHANGE THROUGH SUSTAINABLE ENERGY | DISTRICT - MOHALI

This HDFC Bank Parivartan and YUVA Unstoppable project focuses on reducing carbon footprint for the Directorate of Research and Medical Education (DRME) by installing a 100kW solar panel system. This system aims to cut electricity costs, promote renewable energy, and reduce the institution's carbon footprint, all while contributing to its long-term sustainability. The project also includes continuous system maintenance, monitoring, and training for DRME personnel, ensuring the solar installation operates efficiently.

MITIGATING STUBBLE BURNING

| DISTRICT - LUDHIANA

The entire north India is facing low air quality due to the problem of stubble burning by farmers. This not just affects the quality of life but also degrades the agri-land to a large extent. To mitigate this issue, HDFC Bank Parivartan along with CII Foundation is promoting sustainable agricultural practices. The intervention will focus on:

- Setting up biomass pellet & briguette making units
- Establishing Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) to host and run profit-making rural enterprises
- Setting up straw based mechanised composting & bio-gas units

Apart from the above, young farmers will be trained to provide advisory support and farm tool machinery will be procured and deployed at 27 farmer co-operatives. 15,000 farmers from 126 villages are set to benefit from this intervention that will not just help increase their income but also reduce the problem of stubble burning by 90%.

WEAVING A NEW FUTURE: FROM HARDSHIP TO ENTREPRENEURSHIP

| LOCATION - VILLAGE THEDI | BENEFICIARY - CHINDERPAL KAUR

THE CHALLENGE

Despite being educated, Chinderpal Kaur found herself trapped in a cycle of financial struggle. With no stable employment and only daily wage labor through MGNREGA to rely on, life was uncertain. Her husband's erratic income as a truck driver only added to the instability. Dreams of a better life felt distant, and without formal skills, she saw no clear path forward.

OUR INTERVENTION

In 2022, a door opened. Through the livelihood enhancement project, HDFC Bank Parivartan and Ambuja Foundation introduced Chinderpal to a women's self-help group and provided her with weaving training. Though she started with no experience, her determination was unwavering. She practiced diligently, slowly turning threads into art—and hope.

THE RESULT

Weaving became more than a skill; it became her voice, her power. From student to mentor, she began teaching other women, breaking barriers as she traveled to Delhi and Ahmedabad, gaining exposure and refining her craft. Today, she's a master artisan in the IGNCA Charpai project, earning Rs. 1,500 a day. Her story is no longer one of struggle—it's one of strength, growth, and self-reliance.

FROM STRUGGLES TO SUCCESS: RAKHI'S JOURNEY INTO TECH

LOCATION - MOHALI BENEFICIARY - RAKHI

THE CHALLENGE

Rakhi grew up surrounded by financial hardship. Despite her determination, the lack of exposure to technical education and career opportunities kept her dreams just out of reach. She longed for more—a stable job, a meaningful career, a future she could be proud of—but didn't know where to begin.

OUR INTERVENTION

Everything changed when Rakhi enrolled in the Junior Software Developer course at HDFC Bank Parivartan's Mohali Centre, implemented by Orion Educational Society. With every coding class and workplace training session, her confidence grew. She learned to write code, solve problems, and most importantly—believe in her own potential.

THE RESULT

Rakhi now works as an Executive Engineer at Vertex Infosoft Solution Pvt. Ltd., earning Rs.17,600 a month. What once felt impossible is now her everyday reality. Her journey from uncertainty to success is a powerful reminder that with the right support, even the biggest dreams are within reach.

WOMEN EMPOWERMENT SUMMIT CHAMPIONS RURAL ENTREPRENEURS

At the Women Empowerment Summit 2025 in Moga, Chief Minister S. Bhagwant Singh Mann highlighted women's vital role in the state's progress. Over 600 women shared success stories in farming, technology, and micro-enterprises. Saddi Dharati Women Farmer Producer Company from Barnala launched value-added products like cold-pressed mustard oil and organic pickles, supported by Punjab State Rural Livelihood Mission (PSRLM) and Agricultural Technology Management Agency (ATMA). Engaging 55 women, their enterprise achieved a Rs.5 lakh turnover, proving that skill development and market access empower women-led businesses to drive rural economic growth.

STRENGTHENING LIVELIHOODS & SUSTAINABILITY IN PATHANKOT

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with PHIA Foundation, launched the livelihood enhancement project in Pathankot to enhance natural resource management and livelihoods. The initiative focuses on biodiversity conservation, livelihood diversification, and women's empowerment through 1,200 SHGs. Key government officials pledged support for training, market linkages, and sustainable practices in agriculture and horticulture. With a strong commitment from stakeholders, the project aims to drive long-term community resilience and economic growth in Dharkalan and Bamiyal blocks.





VIRASAT WOMEN EMBRACE 6S FOR WORKPLACE EXCELLENCE

Ambuja Foundation and the Apparel Made-Ups & Home Furnishing Sector Skill Council hosted a 6S event, bringing together 100 women artisans from four stitching units in Punjab. The event focused on improving workplace efficiency through the Six S' - Sort, Set in Order, Shine, Standardize, Sustain, and Safety. Artisans showcased their commitment to these principles, enhancing productivity and safety. Awards recognised the best implementations, fostering motivation and collaboration. This initiative, supported by HDFC Bank Parivartan, continues to empower women through skill development, reviving traditional handicrafts under the Virasat-E-Malwa collective.




