HOLISTIC RURAL DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMME (HRDP)

Rural Rajasthan has a vast opportunity for improvement in a number of fields ranging from agriculture, infrastructure development to even education. HDFC Bank Parivartan, under its Holistic Rural Development Programme worked in the state to sustainably help communities improve their livelihoods through:

- Improved agricultural techniques
- Soil & water conservation measures
- Natural Resource Management (NRM)
- Horticulture
- Orchid development
- Herbal plantation planning

Renovation of school infrastructure, WASH activities, provision of safe drinking water etc. are also taken up to ensure a conducive learning environment in schools & anganwadis.

SUSTAINABLE CRAFT ENTERPRISES FOR A VIBRANT ECOSYSTEM DISTRICT - RAJSAMAND

To foster a vibrant ecosystem in the Devgarh block, HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Urmul Rural Health, Research and Development Trust, is working to harness the potential of value chains to enable holistic socio-economic development across 12 villages. The project will impact 600 families of farmers/mining labourers and artisans through incubation of craft clusters that foster sustainable craft enterprises to subsequently enhance their income. The intervention aims at:

- Training marginal farmers/mining labourers for agri value chain development
- Creating an integrated enterprise hub for agri-foods, and logistics
- Promoting eco-friendly production methods
- Providing skill training to women artisans
- Scaling and strengthening existing artisan skills and empowering craft value chain
- Organising exhibitions and trade fairs to attract buyers
- Establishing smart schools and renovating existing facilities

BUILDING RURAL RESILIENCE IN TRIBAL HEARTLANDS DISTRICT - SIROHI

HDFC Bank Parivartan and SRIJAN are driving rural development across 15 villages in Pindwara block, focusing on water access, renewable energy, and healthcare. The initiative includes water harvesting, solar irrigation, bio-resource centers, and women-led enterprises. With 2,400 acres transitioning to chemical-free farming, this project fosters sustainability and economic empowerment.

This initiative by HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Urmul Rural Health, Research and Development Trust, empowers communities by improving livelihoods, health, education, and social inclusion. Through sustainable farming, women-led enterprises, and educational advancements, the project fosters self-reliance and long-term growth along with enabling economic empowerment through embroidery and craft clusters, strengthening livestock health, and enhancing sanitation. Smart schools, youth programmes, and gender-sensitive community institutions ensure holistic development. With solar streetlights, rainwater harvesting, and clean drinking water, over 30,000 individuals benefit, transforming villages into self-sustaining ecosystems.

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Professional Assistance for Development Action (PRADAN) are transforming the lives of small and marginal women farmers by promoting sustainable agriculture and natural resource management. The project is creating 30,000 acres of irrigated farmland, boosting productivity, food security, and rural incomes while reducing distress migration. Women farmers receive skill training in agriculture, poultry, fisheries, and livestock, enabling them to adopt double cropping and advanced farming techniques. Through farm ponds, bio-resource centers, and micro-irrigation, the initiative fosters self-reliance and resilience, ensuring long-term community impact. This isn't just about farming—it's about securing livelihoods, strengthening rural economies, and empowering women to lead change.

The legacy of traditional handicrafts has been passed down through generations in Rajasthan. Harnessing the community's traditional skills can ensure a steady and drought-resilient source of livelihood. Therefore, HDFC Bank Parivartan and URMUL Seemant Samiti focused on capacity-building for women artisans by providing training and establishing craft centres with the necessary infrastructure. The comprehensive skill-building workshops have economically empowered these women, thereby improving their socio-economic status. These interventions have enabled women to develop craft-based livelihood enterprises and have sensitised communities in the programme areas to adopt crafts as a sustainable, drought-proof alternative.

In a quest to provide mobility and support to patients or Persons with Disability (PwD), HDFC Bank Parivatan is aiding Shree Bhagwan Mahaveer Viklang Sahayata Samiti to provide special aid and equipment to a large number of beneficiaries from the marginal section of the society. This includes supporting them with 18,180 artificial limbs & callipers, 1,413 crutches, 2,590 hand peddled tricycles and 2,056 wheel chairs. Apart from this, 5 special mobile workshops will also be conducted for the beneficiaries over the span of 3 years.

With 1,200 daily outpatient visits, the hospital urgently needs enhanced critical care infrastructure. This initiative strengthens emergency response, ensures life-saving interventions, and improves healthcare access for the community. By equipping the ICU, we're not just upgrading a hospital - we're giving patients a fighting chance, offering hope, and securing a healthier future for the region.

This project is a collaboration between HDFC Bank Parivartan and Doctors for You, aiming to enhance healthcare facilities at Shri Sanwaliya Ji Government General Hospital by setting up an arthroscopy system. This initiative addresses the critical gap in advanced medical equipment needed for joint surgeries and sports injuries. By providing a state-of-the-art arthroscopy system, the project aims to significantly improve the hospital's ability to offer minimally invasive surgeries, benefitting the local population who previously had limited access to such specialised care.

RESTORING LANDSCAPES, EMPOWERING COMMUNITIES

| DISTRICT - BHIWARA, UDAIPUR, RAJSAMAND

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with the Foundation for Ecological Security, is working to revive degraded landscapes through soil and water conservation on common lands, enabling productive use and improved vegetation in 149 villages. The initiative promotes water security in drought-prone regions and encourages sustainable water management in low-rainfall areas. It strengthens local institutions and tenure systems to ensure better governance of natural resources. Community awareness and capacity-building are central to the programme, with a focus on managing shared resources and promoting irrigation through grassroots water governance models, ultimately reducing economic stress and restoring ecological balance.

A BRIGHTER FUTURE: HOW A SOLAR PUMP TRANSFORMED ANTA BAI'S FARM

| LOCATION - GHARAT, SIROHI | BENEFICIARY - ANTA BAI AND HER FAMILY

THE CHALLENGE

For Anta Bai, farming wasn't just work — it was survival. Yet unreliable electricity, soaring power bills, and countless sleepless nights spent irrigating their fields drained her family's strength and hope. Their 3 *bighas* of land stayed mostly dry and underutilised, leaving every harvest hanging by a thread.

OUR INTERVENTION

Change arrived with the support of HDFC Bank Parivartan and Self Reliant Initiatives Through Joint Action (SRIJAN). Anta Bai contributed Rs.40,000, while the Bank provided Rs.1,63,500 to install a solar pump—bringing reliable, affordable irrigation within reach for the first time.

THE RESULT

Today, Anta Bai's fields flourish with wheat, vegetables, and black gram. Her expected earnings have risen by Rs.19,400, and irrigation costs have dropped by Rs.15,000. Most importantly, the endless, exhausting nights are over. With the sun now powering her farm, Anta Bai's family is harvesting not just crops, but a brighter future.

RESTORING WATER, RESTORING LIVELIHOODS

LOCATION - BHILWARA BENEFICIARIES - 42 FARMING HOUSEHOLDS

THE CHALLENGE

In Chainpura village, life has always been at the mercy of the skies. Erratic rainfall and parched fields turned survival into a daily struggle. Crops withered, livestock was sold in distress, and each season carried the haunting fear of drought. With no reliable water source, hope was drying up alongside the land.

OUR INTERVENTION

In 2022, a spark of change was ignited. With the support of HDFC Bank Parivartan and Foundation for Ecological Security (FES), the villagers formed the Charagah Vikas Samiti. Together, they mapped out a water conservation plan and set to work repairing a vital water harvesting structure on the Nakadi river. What began as a dream in March became a reality by April 2022.

THE RESULT

Today, 42 farming families stand stronger. Forty-five acres bloom with secure irrigation, nine wells brim with recharged water, and over 1,900 animals finally have access to safe drinking water. In Chainpura, resilience has taken root — turning dry fields into fertile ground for a brighter, more secure future.



PARIVARTAN STARTUP GRANTS

HDFC Bank has concluded 8 editions of its Parivartan Startup Grants, a key initiative under our Corporate Social Responsibility programme aimed at fostering innovation and social impact across India. Since its inception in 2017, the initiative has disbursed around Rs.80 crore+ in grants, supported over 500+ Startups, and partnered with more than 120+ incubation centres across various sectors, including Environment, Education, Agriculture, and Healthcare.
