KEY INTERVENTIONS

ENHANCING FARMER INCOME

| DISTRICTS - RAMANATHPURAM, SIVAGANGA, PUDUKOTTAI

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with DHAN Foundation, worked across 225 villages in 10 blocks, positively impacting over 20,000 farmers. The initiative focused on nurturing and institutionalizing Farmer Producer Organisations (FPOs) by:

- Introducing and evolving a scalable FPO model
- · Providing hands-on training and mentoring support
- Establishing robust governance systems
- Enhancing productivity through targeted training programs

Progress was closely tracked using rural appraisal techniques, enabling timely interventions and tailored solutions to ensure meaningful, on-ground impact.

FARM BUNDING

| DISTRICT - VIRUDHUNAGAR

HDFC Bank Parivartan and National Agro Foundation, with an aim to provide sustainable income and livelihood, implemented a programme to construct farm bunds across the slope of fields. The programme has covered 262 acres of land, thus aiding multiple farmers to avoid soil erosion, maintain soil moisture and grow healthy crops.

ENHANCING IRRIGATION THROUGH POND RENOVATION

| DISTRICTS - KRISHNAGIRI

For years, farmers battled dry fields and shrinking harvests, their hopes fading with every season. Water scarcity left their lands parched, threatening their livelihoods. HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Mysore Resettlement and Development Agency (MYRADA), is bringing change by:

- Restoring common ponds to boost irrigation
- Replenishing groundwater for sustained farming
- Expanding cultivable land by 34 acres
- Constructing 40 farm ponds to support agriculture
- Promoting chemical-free farming among 230 farmers
- Training 1,600 farmers in soil health and fertilizer use

LAYERED SOLUTIONS FOR RURAL GROWTH

| DISTRICT - TENKASI

Rural communities in Melaneelithanallur struggle with water scarcity, low farm yields, and limited livelihood opportunities. HDFC Bank Parivartan and Hand in Hand India are tackling these challenges, empowering 7,199 individuals, including farmers, women, and school children. The project restores union tanks and ponds to irrigate 300 acres, trains 1,100 farmers in eco-friendly practices, and introduces drought-resilient crops to 325 farmers. It supports 381 community enterprises, upgrades three government schools with smart learning tools, and installs 150 solar streetlights across 15 villages. By strengthening livelihoods, education, and water access, this initiative fosters sustainable rural growth.

| DISTRICT - TIRUCHIRAPALLI

SUSTAINABLY TRANSFORMING RURAL LANDSCAPE

In Manapparai Block, where resources are scarce and opportunities limited, HDFC Bank Parivartan and ASSIST are driving a transformative change. By constructing farm ponds, check dams, and renovating percolation tanks, the project secures water for 4,940 acres, ensuring sustainability for generations. Wastelands are being revived, farmers empowered with natural fertilisers like Azolla, and floriculture expanded with marigolds, creating new income streams. Education is also a priority, with upgraded *anganwadi* centers and solar streetlights improving safety and learning conditions. This initiative is more than development—it's about restoring balance, strengthening livelihoods, and building a resilient future.

SUSTAINABLE APPROACH TO REVOLUTIONISE FARMING

| DISTRICT - KRISHNAGIRI

Farmers in Uthangarai block face pest infestations and declining yields, impacting their livelihoods. HDFC Bank Parivartan and Mysore Resettlement and Development Agency (MYRADA) are addressing these challenges through integrated measures that include:

- Pheromone pest traps to control beetles and borers without chemicals, coconut growth regulators to boost nut yield, high-yielding seed varieties, micronutrient mixtures, and tissue-cultured banana plantlets for uniform, higher yields.
- Soil Health Cards to optimise fertiliser use, green manure cultivation, vermicomposting, and Azolla units for nitrogen fixation, better paddy yields, and livestock feed.
- Solar fencing to prevent wildlife damage and customised hiring centres for affordable machinery access.
- Promotion of agri-allied activities such as fish farming, goat rearing, and dairy farming for income stability.
- Village Development Committees to ensure quality implementation and local participation.

GROWING RESILIENT COMMUNITIES

| DISTRICT - RANIPET

Farmers in Thimiri block face water scarcity, low yields, and limited income. HDFC Bank Parivartan and BAIF Institute for Sustainable Livelihoods and Development are addressing these challenges by empowering 6,800+farmers with better agriculture, water solutions, and education. The project includes five check dams, 20 gabion structures, and drip irrigation for 150 acres to improve water access. It promotes chemical-free farming on 100 acres, supports 50 families in honeybee farming, and provides livestock to enhance income. Additionally, seven schools will receive digital learning tools, and five *anganwadis* will be upgraded with play equipment. By strengthening agriculture, livelihoods, and education, this initiative paves the way for lasting change.

DISTRICT - ARIYALUR

Rural communities thrive when they have the resources to shape their own future. HDFC Bank Parivartan and the National Agro Foundation are empowering farmers and villages to build a self-sustaining ecosystem through water conservation, sustainable farming, and renewable energy. From check dams and farm ponds to smart classrooms and green livelihoods, this initiative is transforming lives. With 3,000 farmers trained, 10,000 trees planted, and thousands of acres revitalised, this project goes beyond development - it nurtures dignity, resilience, and a future where communities thrive independently.

CREATING A BETTER FUTURE THROUGH SMART SCHOOLS

| DISTRICTS - VIRUDHUNAGAR, KRISHNAGIRI, THANJAVUR, CHENNAI

HDFC Bank, in association with the National Agro Foundation (NAF), Mysore Resettlement and Development Agency (MYRADA), Centre for Youth Development and Activities (CYDA) and Yuva Unstoppable, has transformed 110 government schools into smart schools replete with libraries and smart classrooms with digital appliances. It will also involve the renovation/construction of toilets and drinking water facilities in these schools. It's expected to improve the learning capacity of the students who attend these schools.

| STATES - TAMIL NADU, KERALA

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with the Centre for Youth Development and Activities (CYDA), launched the "Smart School Development Project" across 15 schools in Tamil Nadu and Kerala. The initiative introduced science and math labs, smart classrooms, libraries, and clean drinking water facilities. Sanitation units were repaired, and teachers were trained in STEM and digital education. The project not only upgraded infrastructure but also enriched learning experiences and promoted student well-being—paving the way for a more engaging, healthier, and tech-driven future for thousands of young learners.

EMPOWERING ENTREPRENEURIAL WOMEN

| DISTRICTS - MADURAI, MAYILADUTHURAI, THIRUNELVELI, NAGAPATTANAM

HDFC Bank Parivartan with Industree Crafts Foundation worked with the collectivised women producers who own an end-to-end banana value chain. The project supports women entrepreneurs with seed funding and builds networks across collectives and markets, to ensure that the products reach a diverse range of consumers in the regional, national, and international markets. Additionally, 1,400 women were trained on technical and managerial aspects of growing a business. And 1,500 farmers across seven enterprises were trained to become a part of the resilient workforce.

LEARNING WITHOUT LIMITS

| STATES - WEST BENGAL, KARNATAKA, TAMIL NADU, MAHARASHTRA, JHARKHAND AND NORTH EAST

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with Samarthanam Trust for the Disabled, is implementing a 27-month skill development initiative to empower 1,250 youth, including 60% with disabilities. The program offers a structured three-month residential training focused on technical skills, soft skills, and career readiness. A dedicated job fair will facilitate employment for over 500 candidates, engaging 75+ corporate partners. Conducted across 40 batches in Odisha, Mumbai, Pune, and Delhi-NCR, the initiative aims for a 60-65% placement rate, promoting inclusive workforce participation and long-term economic stability.

ENABLING YOUTH FOR A BETTER TOMORROW

| DISTRICT - CHENNAI

HDFC Bank Parivartan along with Dr. Reddy's Foundation is training people with disabilities including individuals who are speech, hearing and visually impaired. The programme's primary focus is on building skillfully strong youth through focused training in core employability skills. The training duration is 60 days for age-groups of 18-35 year olds. The beneficiaries are trained in soft skills, english, communication, digital literacy, work readiness and more.

DEVELOPING A SUSTAINABLE TOMORROW

DISTRICTS - COIMBATORE, NILGIRI

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in collaboration with Keystone Foundation, implemented a programme to address key regional challenges. The initiative promoted diversified, climate-resilient farming systems to strengthen food, nutrition, and income security. Interventions included micro-irrigation to ensure water availability, farmland fencing to prevent runoff, and support for farm- and forest-based enterprises. Spanning 77 villages and benefiting over 2,605 individuals, the programme advanced sustainable livelihoods and long-term community resilience.

PROMOTING COMMUNITY-LED INSTITUTIONS FOR SOCIO-ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT

| DISTRICT - NILGIRIS

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with Action for Community Organisation, Rehabilitation and Development (ACCORD), is implementing a strategic initiative to mobilise farmers and establish village-level producer groups, enhancing their collective bargaining power to secure better prices for their produce. The project is providing training to 1,000 farmers to improve both the quantity and quality of agricultural output. The intervention promotes community enterprises and the creation of sustainable community institutions by scaling existing units for processing, packaging, and marketing produce. Producer groups are actively being formed to enable bulk sourcing and establish new market linkages, leading to increased incomes and fostering comprehensive socio-economic development in the region.

IMPROVING LIVES WITH SERICULTURE

| DISTRICT - KRISHNAGIRI

Sericulture holds immense potential, yet farmers struggle with limited market access and low yields. HDFC Bank Parivartan and Mysore Resettlement and Development Agency (MYRADA) are changing this by empowering 1,415 farmers to turn silk farming into a thriving livelihood. By introducing high-quality cocoon varieties, organic farming, and sustainable irrigation, the project enhances both income and resilience. Community enterprises, training, and shared resources like reeling units and a Sericulture Business Centre ensure long-term success. This initiative is not just about silk—it's about transforming lives, securing futures, and weaving prosperity into the fabric of farming communities.

PRIVATE SANITATION FACILITIES TO ASSURE HEALTH AND SAFETY AT VILLAGE

| DISTRICT - VIRUDHUNAGAR

HDFC Bank Parivartan and National Agro Foundation are constructing a dedicated sanitation complex to benefit 150 women, ensuring access to safe and hygienic facilities at Maravarperungudi village. This intervention not only addresses a basic need but also enhances privacy, safety, and dignity for women in the village. By providing a secure space for sanitation, the project helps reduce health risks and empowers women with a healthier, more respectful environment.

| UNION TERRITORY - PUDUCHERRY

Tuberculosis (TB) remains a major health challenge, with India bearing 27% of the global burden. Committed to ending TB by 2025, the country is expanding early detection and treatment efforts. HDFC Bank Parivartan and Doctors For You are introducing a portable handheld digital X-ray system at District Hospital, Puducherry. This technology ensures faster diagnosis, remote access, reduced waiting times, and efficient data management - crucial for combating TB effectively. Innovations like these accelerate India's fight against TB, bringing life-saving care closer to those in need.

ENHANCING ICU FACILITY AT GB PANT HOSPITAL

| UNION TERRITORY - ANDAMAN AND NICOBAR ISLANDS

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Doctors For You have upgraded the Intensice Care Unit at GB Pant Hospital in Port Blair, strengthening critical care for the Andaman and Nicobar Islands. As the region's primary hospital, GB Pant serves over 1,200 patients daily. With limited healthcare access across the archipelago, enhanced ICU facilities ensure better emergency preparedness, especially during natural disasters. This initiative reinforces life-saving care, improving healthcare outcomes for the island's communities.

TREATING SEPTAGE WITH A PORTABLE UNIT

| DISTRICT - KANYAKUMARI

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with Nagercoil Municipal Corporation, has established a high-efficiency Septage/Sewage Treatment Plant (STP) at Compost Yard Vallampurivilai to improve urban sanitation and environmental health. The facility is designed to treat 50,000 liters of wastewater daily using advanced technology, ensuring safe disposal and enabling reuse where possible. With a compact footprint and a 1.05 lakh-liter collection tank, the plant maximizes treatment capacity while minimizing land use. This initiative not only supports cleaner and more efficient waste management but also reduces public health risks and environmental contamination. By addressing the critical challenge of septage management, the project contributes to building a more sustainable and hygienic urban ecosystem for the residents of Nagercoil.

ESTABLISHING AUTOMATIC WEATHER STATION

| DISTRICT - VIRUDHUNAGAR

In Aladipatti, Maravarperungudi and Vedanatham, farmers were facing problems due to the unpredictability of weather which led them to multiple economic issues. HDFC Bank Parivartan and National Agro Foundation provided them with weather station equipment which has given them access to information about wind speed and direction, temperature, humidity, evaporation and precipitation. The observations are recorded once on an everyday basis. This has helped farmers to be equipped and adapt easily to changes in weather conditions.

SOIL TEST FOR LAND TREATMENT

| DISTRICT - VIRUDHUNAGAR, KRISHNAGIRI, RANIPET

HDFC Bank Parivartan along wtih National Agro Foundation, BAIF Institute for Sustainable Livelihoods and Development and Mysore Resettlement and Development Agency (MYRADA) empowered 600 farmers by facilitating soil testing across nearly 600 acres of farmland. Soil testing plays a vital role in assessing fertility levels, identifying nutrient deficiencies, and detecting potential toxicities or trace mineral imbalances. It also helps track land degradation and improvements over time. With accurate insights into their soil health, farmers were able to adopt targeted agricultural practices, optimize input use, and make informed decisions. As a result, they now enjoy improved crop quality, healthier yields, and increased profits. This intervention not only enhanced productivity but also promoted sustainable farming practices—strengthening rural livelihoods and ensuring long-term soil and environmental health.

INCREASING RAINWATER HARVESTING STRUCTURE | DISTRICTS - VIRUDHUNAGAR, KRISHNAGIRI

In Thiruchuzhi, precious rainwater once flowed straight into the sea, leaving the land dry. To change this, HDFC Bank Parivartan, National Agro Foundation, ASSIST and Mysore Resettlement and Development Agency (MYRADA) built check dams, turning lost water into a life-giving resource. These structures capture rain, recharge groundwater, and replenish wells and borewells after every downpour. With 49 check dams, two rainwater harvesting units, and 11 sunken pits, the region now holds onto its water, securing a better future. This initiative is not just about conserving water—it's about sustaining livelihoods, reviving the land, and ensuring that every drop counts.

REVIVING WATER BODIES, RESTORING BALANCE | DISTRICTS - THOOTHUKUDI, RAMANATHAPURAM

HDFC Bank Parivartan, in partnership with the National Agro Foundation, is spearheading a sustainability initiative across 42 villages. Beyond promoting chemical-free farming for socio-economic upliftment, the project is placing a strong emphasis on rejuvenating natural water bodies. By renovating village ponds and tanks and enhancing the water-holding capacity of surface water sources, the initiative is helping secure long-term water availability for farming and community use. With over 39,000 lives being impacted, the effort is integrating organic farming techniques such as vermicompost, Azolla, and Panchakavya, fostering healthier crops, more resilient ecosystems, and a sustainable future rooted in water conservation.

In a joint effort, HDFC Bank Parivartan and the Centre for Youth Development and Activities have illuminated Tamil Nadu and Kerala with the installation of 150 solar lights. These lights signify a commitment to sustainable energy solutions and community empowerment. The activities include:

WINNING THE BATTLE AGAINST PESTS

LOCATION - KANNIKARANKOTTAI, UTHANGARAI BLOCK, KRISHNAGIRI BENEFICIARY - UTHRA, A COCONUT FARMER

THE CHALLENGE

For Uthra, her coconut grove was more than a livelihood—it was her legacy. But when Rhinoceros beetles began ravaging her 50 trees, each fallen leaf felt like a blow to her hopes. Season after season, she battled the infestation with expensive chemical pesticides, only to see her yields decline and her savings vanish.

OUR INTERVENTION

HDFC Bank Parivartan and Mysore Resettlement and Development Agency (MYRADA) stepped in with a simple yet powerful idea—eco-friendly pheromone traps. Uthra was provided with three traps designed to lure and capture the beetles, breaking their life cycle without harming the environment or her crops.

THE RESULT

Today, Uthra's trees stand tall and green. She saves Rs.2,000 in chemical costs and enjoys healthier yields. More importantly, she has reclaimed her confidence—farming not just to survive, but to thrive, sustainably.

REVIVING A LIFELINE: RESTORING WATER AND HOPE FOR FARMERS

| LOCATION - KADALAIYUR VILLAGE, KOVILPATTI BLOCK, THOOTHUKUDI DISTRICT | BENEFICIARY - 96 FARMERS AND 1,800 COMMUNITY MEMBERS

THE CHALLENGE

Once central to Chettikulam village, the Kanmai tank had gradually deteriorated over the years. Silt accumulation, weakened bunds, and reduced water flow had affected its ability to serve the community. For farmers, this meant challenges in irrigation and lower agricultural yields. Beyond farming, more than 1,800 villagers depended on the tank for drinking water, but with declining groundwater levels, meeting daily needs was becoming increasingly difficult.

OUR INTERVENTION

HDFC Bank Parivartan and National Agro Foundation stepped in with a mission to breathe life back into the Kanmai. The overgrown mesquite (Proposis Juliflora) was cleared, desilting and deepening work revived its capacity, bunds were reinforced, and inlet channels cleared to restore water flow. Every step was taken with long-term water security and agricultural revival in mind.

THE RESULT

The once-dry tank now holds 160 lakh litres of water. Groundwater levels have risen by 1 meter. Farmers who once hoped for a single crop now harvest up to three times a year. A stretch of 110 barren acres is now lush farmland, benefiting 96 farmers over 208 acres. With renewed irrigation and hope, Chettikulam thrives once more.


